A Message from Katherine

Friends,

February 2020 is a slow-ish month, UNTIL the last week of the month. So, while the last week is VERY full, we have three full weeks to take some deep breaths and consider what we will do (or not do) to observe the season of Lent.

Lent is a forty-day season of reflection and preparation that precedes the celebration of Easter. It mirrors the forty-days Jesus spent in the wilderness – days of fasting, days of solitude, days of temptation – a entire season of spiritual practice and preparation for ministry.

How will you observe the season of Lent? I suggest choosing one thing – something you can "stick with" for forty days. Here are some ideas:

Try something new like: daily prayer or meditation, daily exercise, no-meat Mondays (or Fridays or any day), donating one box/bag a week to charity, reading a 40-day devotional, writing hand-written notes to people who have impacted your life, creating art or music, a weekly service project of sometime, deepening a particular relationship or practicing forgiveness – these are just a few.

Set something aside like: electronics (or electronics at mealtime), toxic relationships, self-doubt, diet drinks, chocolate, shopping beyond absolute necessities, over-functioning, minimizing or shaming self-talk, texting while driving (doing so is illegal in NC) – these are just a few.

Commit to a simple daily devotional: I am going to try "Pauses for Lent: 40 Words for 40 Days" by Trevor Hudson (Upper Rooms Press: Nashville, 2015.) He assigns each day a "word" (e.g. choose, rest, water, prune), provides a short devotion and suggests a simple practice.

And when life sneaks up on you? Remember: Lent is about practice, not perfection.

The ascension of Jesus becomes, then, the beginning of the life of believers, who are empowered by the Spirit to follow their Lord and make known the message of God's saving acts in Christ.

This class meets in the Adult Center during Sunday Christian Education Hour. This class discusses contemporary topics with the assistance of youtube videos and TEDTalks. They meet in the Adult Center on Sunday mornings.
