#### MISSIONS UPDATE

#### **Urban Ministries**

St. Giles has a long connection to Urban Ministries of Wake County (https://urbanmin.org/). We annually donate funds to support their work, and we have budgeted to do so again in 2021. In the past, our congregation has collected food for their pantry which through Covid continues to serve up to 90 cars a day in a drive-through format... helping 40,000 people in just the past 10 months. Back when inperson volunteering was safer, our members helped stock the food



pantry as well as work the reception and intake desks at their Open Door walk in clinic / pharmacy (which serves more than 1,500 uninsured adults and provides about 39,000 prescriptions each year). While our in-person volunteering is restricted during the pandemic, know that that your offering helps financially support this mission and that we are in touch with Urban Ministries' leadership to explore how else we can work together when in-person volunteering is safer again. # **Habitat for Humanity**



Winter and the pandemic have not stopped the local Presbyterian coalition and Habitat for Humanity's work with Tenina Kennedy and her family. The new home your donations are building in the Dowling Ridge neighborhood is nearing completion! Since my December update, the siding has been installed and many of the interior features like cabinets, flooring, and lighting are installed. The house still needs exterior paint, the driveway poured, etc. Stay tuned for details of a planned virtual dedication and blessing of the new home and family in April or May. We are hopeful that Habitat will again be able to use our

#### **Community Hope**

Reunited in HOPE! The new year brings YMCA of the Triangle's Community HOPE program back to St. Giles' campus! Community HOPE provides learning, mentoring and enriching activities for children in Raleigh's affordable housing communities. St. Giles has a long history of financial support and volunteering with them. Last year, Community HOPE moved to meeting during school hours -- helping children in our neighborhood overcome the difficulties of remote learning through the pandemic. They needed a new place for that, and your session approved waiving Youth Center use fees starting in January. The YMCA staff are trained and experienced in serving students through the pandemic; they get to know each child's individual needs and support their learning. Warm lunches are provided by the county school system. The YMCA has a team that monitors rules and best-practices for student health, including densities to fit the space, health questionnaires, temperature checks, masking, hand washing, cleaning the space, etc. We look forward to deepening the already strong relationship with Community HOPE!
